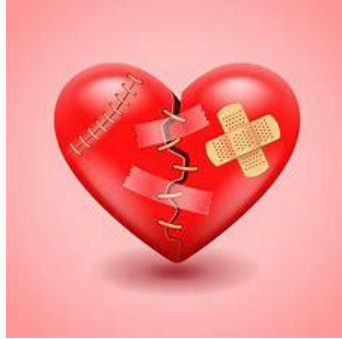

1. Al-Jubbar has two meanings. Mention them and explain each. Explain how is both meanings apply together. Explain how is related to the name Algebra.

- a. The Mighty. Allah has such immense amount of power that is very impressive. It's so great that it's beyond our comprehension. He uses his power to break down oppressors.
  - b. The Mender of Broken spirits. The one who heals broken hearts. Allah can mend anything that is broken, whether it is emotional, physical or mental.
  - c. Allah is Jubbar in two different ways. He is Jubbar to the oppressors and Jubbar to the oppressed. He is Jubbar in crushing the oppressors and He is Jubbar in compensating the victims. He is Jubbar to both parties.
  - d. Al-Jubbar is relevant to both the oppressor and the oppressed.
  - e. In the Day of Judgment, people will be called to rise from death to appear before Al-Jubbar. This name in particular is used because it applies to punishing the oppressors and relieving the oppresses.
  - f. The Name Al-Jubbar was mentioned once in the Quran ().
  - g. Algebra is an Arabic word that means mending the fractions. It is science invented by [Alkhawarizmi](#). (The word Algorithm was derived from the name of the Muslim Scientist Alkhawarizmi. He is known to be the father of computations. He also was the one who invented the Zero. He is the inventor of calculus).
2. How did Allah was Jubbar to the king who claimed to give life and death and threw Ibrahim in the fire, and how was he Jubbar with Ibrahim?
    - a. Allah destroyed that king in a very harsh way. Allah made a little insect go in his ear made him severely suffer. The insect would buzz and roam around inside him and it would make him extremely rustles. He couldn't even peacefully sleep nor do anything. When it would start moving and
