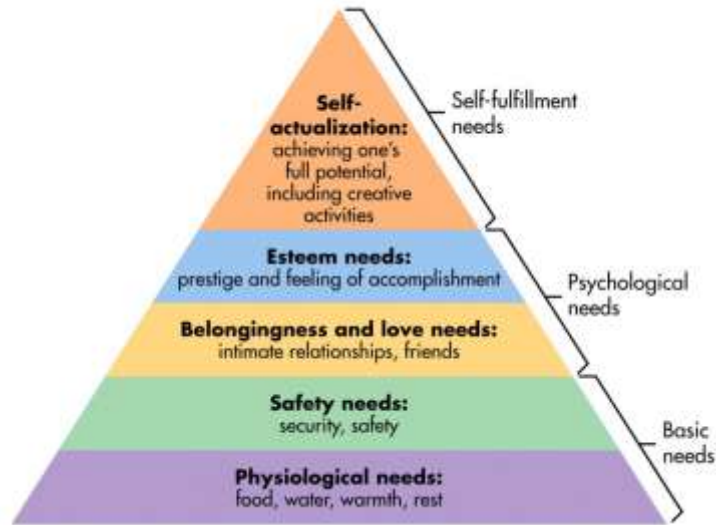


Meanings

- Al-Raziq and Al-Razzaq
- الرزاق، الرازق
- The Supplier of All, The Sustenance Provider, The Provision Supplier, The One Who Divides Shares of Rizq Among People and The One who Supplies us with our Needs. The One Who Gives.
- Al-Ruzzaq is the hyperbolic form of Al-Raziq, In other words, Al-Ruzzaq is the supreme Raziq
- Al-Ruzzaq is the nature of Allah while Al-Raziq is the actions of Allah, because he is Al-Ruzzaq, he provide Rizq.
- Al-Raziq is the one who assigns Rizq to his creation and Al-Ruzzaq is the one who delivers the assigned Rizq.
- Al-Ruzzaq is a name of greatness and only for Allah but Al-Raziq is a name of beauty that Allah wants us to practice in our life by providing supplies to others.
- Al-Raziq is the provider but Al-Ruzzaq is the one that gives plenty of Rizq.
- Al-Raziq is the one who continuously provides and Al-Ruzzaq is the one who provides plenty of Rizq.
- Al-Rizq is two kinds: general Rizq for the body provided to all of his creations and specific for believers, which is providing faith to the hearts of believers.
- Al-Ruzzaq was reported once in the Quran in (51:58) إِنَّ اللَّهَ هُوَ الرَّزَّاقُ ذُو الْقُوَّةِ الْمَتِينُ

 - People worshiped the sun because it provides for them light and heat.
 - Some worshiped cows because it provides us with milk and beef.
- Rizq is not wealth only. Rizq is something that brings benefit or that which repels harm. Food, drink, wealth, fame, beauty, happiness, attractiveness, good children (children are a source of joy or a source of pain), spouse, parents, feeling of satisfaction, luck, housing, life length, accomplishments, love and be loved, all items in Maslow pyramid.
